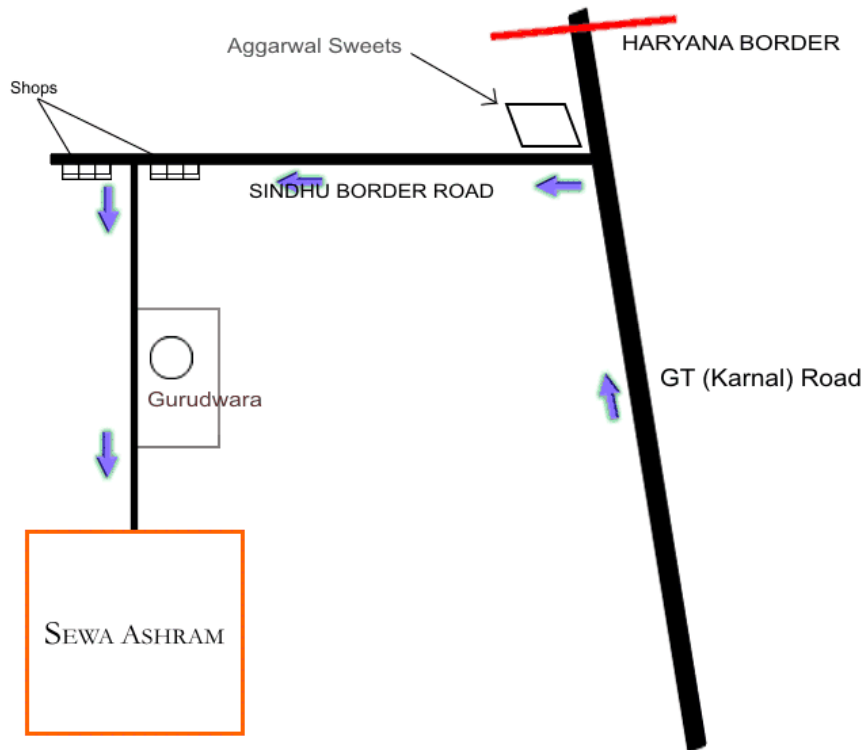


# Directions to Sewa Ashram

Singhu Border Road

**From the airport:**  
Go to the Delhi Police Pre-Paid taxi booth and request a ride to "Singhu Border" or "Narela." The fare should be about 400 - 500 rupees and will take over one hour to get here, longer in bad traffic.

Request (or demand) that the driver take "Ring Road to GT Karnal Road" to avoid a slower, meandering rural route which does not match our landmarks in the directions below.

## Driving Directions to Sewa Ashram:

Take the **Ring Road to GT (Grand Trunk) Road** heading **North** out of Delhi in the direction of "**Karnal**". You will pass through a major intersection of GT Karnal Road and Outer Ring Road. It is surrounded by a huge garbage pit. From this point, it is 14 km until your next turn on Singhu Border Road.

You will see **6 gas stations in a row** on the left side of the street (the first one is an HP). If you look ahead, you will see the Delhi/Haryana border crossing. Immediately after the gas stations, you will take a **LEFT on Singhu Border Road**. "Singhu Border Road" will be printed on the bus stop signs right before the turn. There are usually lots of buses right around the turn and an Aggarwal Sweets shop right at the corner. If you cross the Delhi / Haryana border you went too far.

Go down Singhu Border Road for 1.5 km. You will cross a little bridge and see fields and monkeys. When you see the first row of shops on your left and a **white Temple dome (Gurudwara)**, take the **first left between the shops**. You will see Sewa Ashram's yellow wall with orange gate at the end of the road and will drive right past the white temple dome. If you have any problems once you make the turn, ask anyone in the neighborhood, they all know us.
